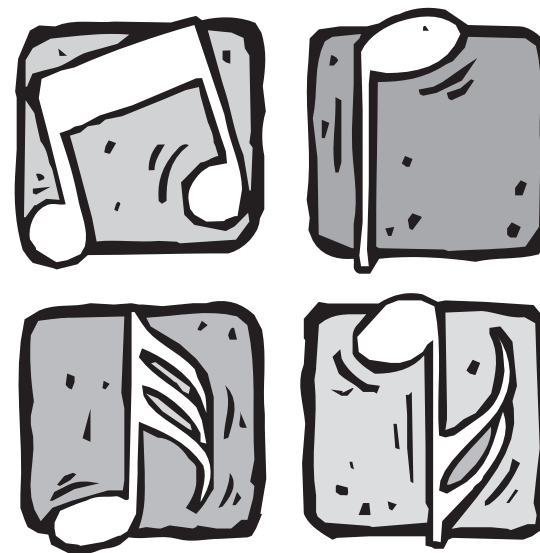

⇒ ATTENDANCE POLICY ⇐

All members are expected to attend every rehearsal and to be seated 5 minutes prior to the start of YOUR rehearsal time and 6:50 pm for concerts. Report absence prior to rehearsal to Patricia Cosand, 480 688-7499 or ysswmail@gmail.com. Excused absences include school concerts, illness and family emergencies.

⇒ MEMBER COMMITMENT ⇐

Each member is expected to prepare his/her part diligently prior to each rehearsal. Students are expected to be members in good standing of their high school orchestra or band where applicable.

⇒ CONCERT ATTIRE ⇐

Ladies: long sleeve black blouse, long black skirt (this must be to the ankle) or black dress slacks and shoes with black hosiery

Gentlemen: black tuxedo with white dress shirt, black shoes and black socks

⇒ STRING SEATING POLICY ⇐

There will be a chair placement audition during a rehearsal prior to each concert. Students must be in attendance at the rehearsal or be moved to the end of their section.

⇒ WIND SEATING POLICY ⇐

Wind reseating will be scheduled upon request, at the discretion of the music director.

⇒ WEBSITE ⇐

The website yssw.symphonyofthesouthwest.org will be updated frequently to include rehearsal and performance dates and repertoire. A student photo slideshow will be included (photos only no names). ⇒ STATEMENT OF PURPOSE ⇐

The Youth Symphony of the Southwest was founded in 2006 for the express purpose of supporting and fostering the highest quality of music education and to inspire and nurture the love of symphonic repertoire by offering hands-on experience to qualified high school students through age 20.*

⇒ MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS ⇐

Students in high school, through age 20 may audition for a seat in the orchestra. All instrumentalists must demonstrate proficiency in:

Strings: All major and melodic minor scales and arpeggios in all keys, a movement from a standard solo, and sight reading.

Woodwinds and Brass: Major and melodic minor scales (in 2 octaves if possible) through 4 sharps and flats, a chromatic scale covering the entire range of the instrument, a movement from a standard solo, and sight reading.

⇒ TUITION ⇐

\$350.00/year Payable to: Youth Symphony of the Southwest

Tuition must be paid in one of the following ways:

1. September 14 in full \$350
2. September 14, \$179, and January 4, \$179
3. September 14, \$120, January 4, \$120, February 9, \$120

Checks, cash and PayPal accepted, access PayPal through the website.

⇒ MUSIC POLICY ⇐

At first rehearsal, music will be distributed. At the end of each concert music must be returned in good condition. Any damaged or lost music will be replaced at the musician's expense.

⇒ REHEARSAL ETIQUETTE ⇐

- All electronic devices must be turned off during rehearsal. This includes text messaging.
- Water only in the rehearsal room.
- No food or gum in the rehearsal room.
